The newly created Global Church Leadership professorship is envisioned as a research unit focusing on ecclesiastical leadership, strategy, administration, management, and other specific issues important in the life of the Church.

The yearly Academy of Global Church Leadership will be offered as an intensive 3-days seminar focused on a particular relevant topic, beginning with “Church Financing” in May 2024.

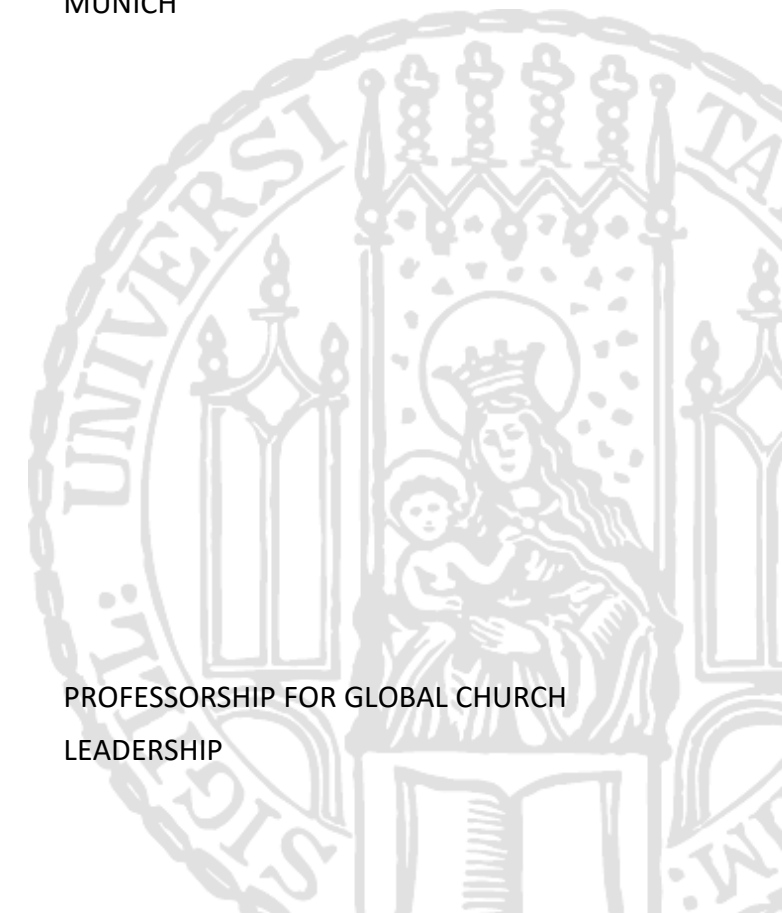
