

Scholarship programme for a four-month research stay at the Professorship of Global Church Leadership at the LMU

1. Preamble

missio-Munich, to encourage sound theological training and good leadership in the Church, makes available funding for a four-month research stay at the LMU's Professorship of Global Church Leadership.

The scholarship will cover the selected applicants' flights to and from Munich and accommodation expenses.

2. Who can apply for a scholarship?

This scholarship is open to doctoral and master's students who are currently conducting research within the scope of the Professorship of Global Church Leadership's research and teaching fields.

This scholarship is open to the lay faithful, members of the consecrated life, and clerics. Members of the consecrated life and clerics must obtain prior approval from their legitimate superiors. Lay people will also require a recommendation from their local ordinary or proper parish priest.

3. Beneficiaries

All doctoral and master's students currently conducting research within the scope of the Professorship of Global Church Leadership's research and teaching fields can apply for this scholarship. This includes topics related to or of interest to church leadership, administration, lay participation, evangelisation, and so on.

Currently holding, or being destined to hold, a leadership position in a local church, religious community, or church institution will be advantageous.

4. Rules for awarding scholarships and application procedures

Details on the awarding of scholarships are found in the 'Guidelines for Awarding Scholarships' document.

Read these carefully before applying! To be considered for a scholarship, you must submit a completed application form and all the necessary supporting documents before:

- 01 April for the research stay during the next winter semester (October)
- 01 October for the research stay during the next summer semester (April)
