Funding Requirements

- Signed mentoring agreement with approved mentor.
- Filled out funding request form including information on the neccessity of funding for the advancement of the personal academic career.
- Written approval of the funding request by the Mentoring Commission of the Munich School of Management.
 Request for funding for can be submitted via email to mentoring@som.lmu.de
- The mentee is responsible for ensuring that invoices can be paid within the payment deadline. If late submission of invoices results in penalties, they must be borne by the mentee.
- In the case of incomplete applications and/or incorrect or incomplete documents submitted for billing, the
 Mentoring Commission of the Faculty of Business Administration reserves the right to reject the application.

Eligible are all expenses that benefit the personal academic career.

- Student assistants, other scientific assistants, or research assistants:
 The hiring process is carried out by the institute of the mentee submitting the application.
 Assistants are charged to the account (AOST) of the mentoring project. The required accounting information will be provided upon approval of the application. The employment contract must be signed by the heads of the mentoring program.
