Description

This workshop provides a practical introduction to environmental monitoring in food production environments. Participants will learn key principles of environmental monitoring and how they are used to validate and verify cleaning and sanitation programs.

Participants will learn how to design a risk-based sampling plan, identify meaningful sampling sites in a hands-on site visit, and understand what different test results can—and cannot—tell you. The workshop combines short lectures with group exercises and hands-on sampling activities, allowing participants to apply the concepts directly.

Objectives

After completing this workshop, participants will be able to:

- to explain the role of environmental monitoring within the broader GMP context
- develop a sampling plan
- understand basic concepts for using the resulting data.
