



## Attendance list for colloquia (1,5 ECTS, i.e. attending 20 presentations required)

To successfully complete the Master of Science program in Human Biology – Principles of Health and Disease, you must earn 1.5 ECTS credits through attendance at scientific colloquia.

This corresponds to attending 20 scientific presentations (in person or online) during your master's program.

### Requirements and Guidelines

- Each presentation must last at least 45 minutes, followed by a discussion session.
- You are encouraged to actively participate in the discussion by asking questions or contributing comments.
- Eligible presentations include talks by invited speakers hosted by, for example:
  - Graduate schools
  - Gene Center
  - Department of Biochemistry
  - Max Planck Institutes
- If you attend an online talk, please indicate this within the signature section of the list.
- Please note: Regular work group seminars do not count as colloquia for this requirement.

### Confirmation of Attendance

At the end of each colloquium — after all questions have been answered and the organizer has thanked the speaker — you may ask the host (usually the faculty member who introduced the speaker) to sign your attendance list as confirmation.

Please ensure that signatures are collected only after the official conclusion of the event.
