Topic: Assistance in a study on the migraine cycle at Klinikum Großhadern.

This study investigates different phases of the migraine cycle using various MRI techniques, including perfusion imaging and functional connectivity. In addition, the concentration of the protein CGRP (Calcitonin Gene-Related Peptide) is measured.

Tasks:

- Supporting MRI sessions (e.g., preparing participants, assisting with the procedure)
- Performing lab work (ELISA)
- General support with the study process

Requirements:

- Enrollment in a relevant field of study (e.g., biology, medicine)
- Sufficient German language skills are essential for communicating with study participants
- Interest in clinical research and neuroimaging methods
- Motivation, reliability, ability to work independently, and team spirit
- Hands-on experience with wet lab techniques, preferably ELISA
