

Emergency plan

Fire department – Rescue service – Emergency service **112**

If possible, accidents should be reported by witnesses or persons involved

Who	<i>is calling</i>	
Where	<i>did the accident happen</i>	
What	<i>happened</i>	<i>Fire, chemical burn, fall etc.</i>
Which	<i>injuries</i>	<i>Type and affected body parts</i>
How many	<i>persons injured</i>	<i>Number of injured persons</i>

Never hang up before the Rescue Coordination Center has ended the call!
Ensure local briefing of the emergency staff!

Then(!) in case of fire / escape of hazardous substances call internal emergency number **2180-8888**

and start the procedure for evacuating the building

Then inform security service / facility service

The security service ensures free access of rescue vehicles

Security service: 2180-2313

Facility service: Angelica Dore 2180-6504

In case of severe injuries (burns, chemical burns, eye injuries, serious injuries) always call the emergency service!

In case of minor injuries go to the nearest surgical outpatient clinic or accident insurance doctor (Durchgangsarzt) – provided that the circulation is stable and the injured person is accompanied!
