The „Promotionsprogramm Altertumswissenschaften“ (PAW) is part of the Münchner Zentrum für Antike Welten (MZAW). The participating disciplines share a common interest in the ancient world, which they approach with their specialized methods and perspectives. This broad foundation allows doctoral students both an in-depth engagement with the culture they study in their dissertation and an interdisciplinary enrichment of their theoretical and methodological approach.

Participation in the program promotes interdisciplinary exchange and networking among doctoral candidates. Additionally, academic training opportunities and help from varied experts enhance the quality of the doctoral research. This includes doctoral colloquia and accompanying interdisciplinary courses. Furthermore, the PAW supports doctoral students with travel expenses for conferences and research trips, the organization of academic events (workshops, conferences), and the acquisition of academic and professional skills (e.g., teaching experience, internships).

The program is designed to last three years but can be extended upon agreement.

Doctoral research supervision is carried out by a primary advisor, who has the main academic responsibility and is a professor at LMU Munich as well as a member of the MZAW. Additionally, one or two further advisors act in a consultative role. The advisors can be proposed by the doctoral student and provide guidance on research progress and career planning.

A supervision agreement is concluded between the advisors, the doctoral student, and the MZAW chairman.

Applications can be submitted at any time.

Admission decisions are made at the following MZAW board meeting.

Required documents (in digital format, as a single PDF file):

- Cover letter explaining motivation
- Curriculum vitae with a detailed academic history and, if applicable, a list of publications
- Dissertation proposal (up to five pages)
- Reference letter from the dissertation advisor (to be sent directly to the PAW coordination)

- Completed university degree
- Excellent academic qualifications
- Acceptance as a doctoral candidate at LMU Munich in one of the disciplines of the MZAW
- Interest in interdisciplinary academic exchange

- Support in planning and organizing workshops and conferences
- Access to MZAW partners (e.g., Archäologische Staatssammlung, Museum für Abgüsse Klassischer Bildwerke, Staatliche Antikensammlungen und Glyptothek, Staatliche Münzsammlung, Staatliches Museum Ägyptischer Kunst, Kommission für Alte Geschichte und Epigraphik des DAI, Propylaeum - Fachinformationsdienst Altertumswissenschaften, etc.)

- Participation in lectures and seminars of the MZAW Visiting Professorship
