



LMU Gateway – Declaration of consent

Declaration of consent to publication of my data on LMU's websites and LMU Gateway's newsletters

To the extent required for official purposes and/or in order for LMU Gateway to fulfil its responsibilities, I agree to my personal data as specified below being posted in connection with coverage on the above event and/or the work of LMU Gateway on LMU's websites and the LMU Gateway's newsletters.

No remuneration is paid for the granting of rights in photos, which also encompass the photo-editing right provided the result is not disfiguring. I grant LMU in perpetuity and with no restrictions in terms of territory a non-exclusive right of use in the photos provided, and I warrant that said photos are clear of third-party rights. This consent does not include sound and video recordings or film footage.

I am aware that having my personal data published electronically can also incur certain risks, such as in particular the risk of unwanted contacting, commercial use by third parties and unauthorised circulation. There is also a risk of my data being used for unwelcome analysis or profiling, or being fused with other data. Moreover, published data can be intercepted unnoticed and may be stored, modified, falsified or manipulated at unknown locations. After the data has been removed from LMU's websites, there is a risk of the data still being publicly accessible elsewhere in the Internet. LMU is unable to ensure that the data will no longer be able to be found anywhere else in the Internet once it has been removed from LMU's websites.

I understand that issuing this declaration of consent is voluntary, and that I will not suffer any disadvantages if I choose not to grant consent.

Consent can be withdrawn at any time with effect going forward. The withdrawal of consent will not affect the lawfulness of any data processing that has been done before the withdrawal date. In the event of withdrawal of consent, the published data will be removed promptly provided it does not have to be published by law. I have taken note of the fact that even after consent has been withdrawn, it may still be possible to find my personal data elsewhere in the Internet and Instagram: its complete removal from accessible third-party websites cannot be guaranteed. This declaration of consent takes effect on the date of signature and will remain in force indefinitely. In order to comply with the obligation to furnish proof under data protection law, this declaration of consent will be stored in compliance with provisions relating to data protection for a maximum period of 30 years after publication of my personal data has terminated (German Civil Code, Sect. 199(3) No. 2).
