

## **LMU-TAU Research Cooperation Program**

### **Call for Applications for Workshops in 2023**

As part of the LMU-TAU Research Cooperation Program, Ludwig-Maximilians-Universität München (LMU) and Tel Aviv University (TAU) support workshops conducted jointly by researchers from both universities.

#### **Eligibility**

LMU and TAU faculty members are eligible to submit the applications. Collaborators from other institutions besides TAU and LMU can participate in the workshops but are not eligible for any financial support from TAU or LMU.

#### **Funding**

Successful joint proposals will receive up to a maximum of €15,000 overall. TAU will provide each approved project up to €7,500, and LMU will provide each approved project up to €7,500, each in support of their respective researchers.

The costs of travel and accommodation as well as daily allowance will be reimbursed by both universities in accordance with their own regulations.

- Name of LMU and TAU applicant, affiliation (department, institute)
- Names of the cooperating partners
- Short description of the project (up to 3 pages)
- Detailed LMU and TAU budget
- Other sources of funding

#### **Submission of Applications**

Applications for workshops in 2023 should be prepared jointly and submitted to TAU and LMU by **7th November 2022**.
