Aims

At the end of the module, the participants will be able to:

- Understand One Health and the importance of digital storytelling in public health initiatives.
- Develop an idea for a digital storyboard.
- Explore different writing styles in Digital storytelling.
- Differentiate between scientific writing and storytelling.
- Explore storyboarding concepts.
- Use the software "PageFlow" to create your own digital story.

Format

- 3 Synchronous Sessions
- 5 Units of asynchronous interactive eLearning
- Scope: 90 working hours in 10 weeks

Content:

Topics include:

- Science communication.
- Writing techniques.
- Creating storyboards.
- Self-Competence and providing peer feedback.

Assessment:

The final assessment is composed of 6 parts:

- 1. **Assignment 1:** writing a short topic proposal (5%)
- 2. **Assignment 2**: writing a script for the digital story (20%)
- 3. **Assignment 3**: submitting the elements of the storyboard (5%)
- 4. Assignment 4: submitting the first draft of the storyboard on PageFlow (10%)
- 5. **Assignment 5**: submitting the final version of the digital story on PageFlow (50%)
- 6. Participation in quizzes, discussion forums, and Moodle tasks: (10%)
