



Grant for German Language Courses

The funding consists of **up to €150 one-time payment**.

You are only eligible to receive the grant and apply for it if you have already taken a German course prior to the German course for which you are applying for the grant.

Who can apply:

Students/doctoral students (not including students on preparatory courses, exchange students, program students) who are **registered at the time of application for regular full-time study programs** and who:

- Have already attended at least one German language course and can proof the attendance;
- Have successfully completed the German course (at least 80% attendance);
- Have **not** taken their Abitur (higher education entrance qualification) or/and has not gained a German university degree in the Federal Republic of Germany (or in a German school in a foreign country).

Application documents

1. Bachelor certificate (if already available);
2. Master certificate (if already available);
3. Letter of motivation;
4. Registration certificate for the current semester;
5. Certificate of attendance for the previous German course;
6. Invoice and confirmation of payment (bank statement) for the German language course for which the grant is being requested;
7. Proof of at least 80% attendance in the German course for which the grant is being requested (certificate of attendance);
8. Statement of financial need;
9. Application form.
