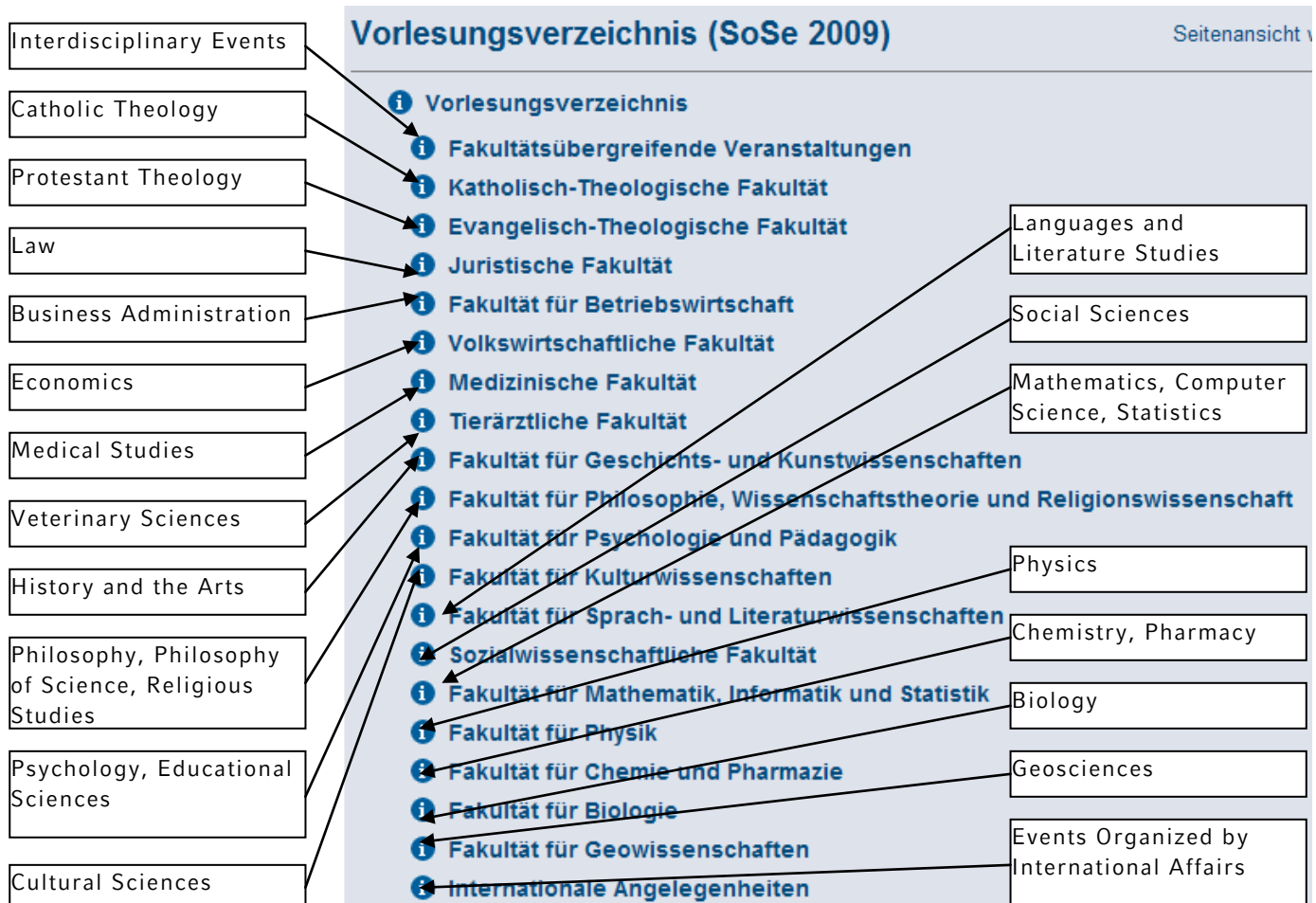


The Online Course Catalogue

Description	Jointly with the lecture 'Internationale Beziehungen I', the Basic Course introduces students to the subfield of International Relations (IR). In the first part, the course will discuss key theories of IR, including Realism, Institutionalism, Liberalism, Constructivism and Poststructuralist theories of international politics. The second part will apply these theories to concrete empirical events and policy areas such as security, economics, development, the environment and human rights. By the end of the course, students should be able to apply different IR theories and thereby explain different international political phenomena.

2.) Checking for Courses Taught in English
