If you experience symptoms you can get tested at your general practitioner after having made an appointment by telephone. If you don't yet have a general practitioner, you can make an appointment at the test station on Theresienwiese: <https://www.corona-testung.de>

You can also visit the medical practice for patients with typical corona symptoms on Theresienwiese (Matthias-Pschorr-Straße 4). Patients can go there during the opening hours without an extra appointment. Opening hours are as follows: Monday, Tuesday, and Thursday from 18:00 to 21:00, Wednesday and Friday from 16:00 to 21:00, and Saturday, Sunday and holidays from 10:00 to 21:00.
